Militia that can redeploy may redeploy unstacked on any city or town in that state.

Deploy 9 partisan cadres in any state or territory that was originally neutral or Confederate, 6 on west maps A and B and 3 on east map C.

A second turn entrenchment marker is placed on 4 stacks with 10 infantry strength points.

Set up on Production Chart

5/64	8 Militia.
6/64	4 Infantry, 6 Garrison, 20-40 in B4117.
7/64	4 Infantry, 8 Cavalry.

The game begins with Game Turn of 1/04/64 (March 27, 1864),
do not perform the 0/04/64 Strategic Turn.

For the 0/5/64 Strategic Turn, the Confederacy is on the 5th box of the 2nd Draft.

Their General Supply level is 25. Each side may create new HQs up to their counter limits.

Kentucky and Missouri are Union states. The Emancipation Proclamation has been issued.

Army Leader Pool: None. Historical Future Leader Pool: S.D. Lee.

Dead Leader Pool: A.S. Johnston, Huger, Van Dorn, Jackson, Gardner, Holmes, Floyd.

The 8th Infantry Corps has been destroyed (at Vicksburg).

The Political point total is +10.

The North has made 2 failing Political appeals, the South has made 4 failing appeals.

The following supply cities and towns are in the Union sympathetic area and must each be occupied by a Confederate land unit to contribute to Confederate supply or be a militia placement hex: Knoxville, TN; Chattanooga, TN; Bristol, TN; Cleveland, TN; Dalton, GA, Huntsville, AL; Greenville, SC; Staunton, VA, Winchester, VA. The following non-supply towns and villages are also in this area and must be occupied to be a militia placement hex: Stevenson, AL; Saltville, VA; Marion, VA; Wytheville, VA; New Market, VA; Strasbourg, VA; and Front Royal, VA. All of these may be marked with a blue bingo chip or a blue mark on the map to indicate this. If any of the above are not occupied by a Confederate unit, they revert to being Union sympathetic.
